The special meeting of Fremont City Council was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the form prescribed by the General Rules of Council. President Pro Tem Ruiz called the meeting to order. The following members answered roll call: Knisely, Otte, Zilch, Ruiz, Stout, Koebel, and Taylor.

Second reading of an ordinance amending appropriations within Capital Improvement Fund 410, and declaring an emergency. On a motion to suspend Rule 4 by Mr. Knisely and seconded by Mr. Otte. Motion carried 7 yea votes. On a motion to adopt by Mr. Knisely and seconded by Mr. Otte. Motion carried 7 yea votes. Ord. 2017-3848

First reading of an ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Safety Service Director to enter into an employment contract with the Ohio Patrolman's Benevolent Association representing full time officers for the Fremont Police Department and declaring an emergency. On a motion to suspend Rule 4 by Mr. Knisely and seconded by Mrs. Stout. Motion carried 7 yea votes. On a motion to adopt by Mr. Knisely and seconded by Mr. Taylor. Motion carried 7 yea votes. First reading of an ordinance authorizing the Safety Service Director to submit a written agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's Annual Winter Road Salt Contract (018-18) in accordance with Revised Code Section 5513.01 (B) and declaring an emergency. On a motion to suspend Rule 4 by Mr. Taylor and seconded by Mrs. Stout. Motion carried 7 yea votes. On a motion to adopt by Mr. Knisely and seconded by Mrs. Stout. Motion carried 7 yea votes. Ord. 2017-3850

First reading of an ordinance amending appropriations within Street Maintenance Fund 222, and declaring an emergency. On a motion to suspend Rule 4 by Mr. Zilch and seconded by Mr. Knisely. Motion carried 7 yea votes. On a motion to adopt by Mr. Knisely and seconded by Mr. Zilch. Motion carried 7 yea votes. Ord. 2017-3851

First reading of a resolution suspending Sections 941.03 (D) and (I) prohibition of alcohol in a Public Park Subject to State Permit Regulations; on May 26, 2017 for the purpose of holding a Professional Boxing Event sponsored by Nelson's Promotions solely at the Fremont Recreation Center and declaring an emergency. On a motion to suspend Rule 4 by Mr. Knisely and seconded by Mr. Otte. Motion carried 7 yea votes. On a motion to adopt by Mr. Knisely and seconded by Mrs. Stout. Motion carried 6 yea votes to 1 abstain vote. Res. 2017-2011
