

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-385

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FREMONT CHAPTER 131 THE POLICE DEPARTMENT CODE SECTION 131.01 COMPOSITION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City desires to amend the codified ordinances of the City of Fremont Chapter 131 The Police Department Code Section 131.01 Composition, and

WHEREAS, the amendment proposed is described herein:

Section 131.01 which currently reads as follows:

131.01 COMPOSITION

The Police Department shall consist of a Chief of Police, four Captains, four Sergeants, twenty-four Patrolmen, one civilian Records Clerk, one Secretary of Support Services, four civilian Dispatchers, and such reserve, special, part-time, or parking patrolmen as may be necessary.

Section 131.01 shall hereby be amended to read as follows:

131.01 COMPOSITION

The Police Department shall consist of a Chief of Police, one Captain, seven Sergeants, twenty-four Patrolmen, one civilian Records Clerk, one Secretary of Support Services, five civilian Dispatchers, and such reserve, special, part-time, or parking patrolmen as may be necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the codified ordinances of the City of Fremont Chapter 131 The Police Department is hereby amended to reflect the change to Section 131.01.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. The immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the immediate need to pass the amendment in an expeditious manner in order to have the Fremont Police Department reorganized by July 1, 2017.

This ordinance, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.


