

RESOLUTION NO 2016- 1971

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING STEPHANIE MARTIN, CITY COUNCIL CLERK, AS DESIGNEE FOR ELECTED MEMBERS OF FREMONT CITY COUNCIL FOR PUBLIC RECORDS TRAINING AS REQUIRED BY R.C. 109.43(B) FOR THE YEARS 2016-2019, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, all local and statewide elected government officials or their designees must attend a public records training program during each term of elective office during which the official serves to enhance understanding of public records; and

WHEREAS, the training must be developed and certified by the Ohio Attorney General's Office, and presented either by the Ohio Attorney General's Office or an approved entity with which the Attorney General's Office contracts; and

WHEREAS, R.C. 109.43(B) provides that training shall be three hours for every term of office for which the elected official was appointed or elected to the public office; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to comply with R.C. 109.43(B) as it applies to all members of Fremont City Council and there is currently no designee for public records training for the term of elected officials serving from 2016-2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That pursuant to R.C. 109.43(B) Stephanie Martin shall be designee for Fremont City Council members for public records training for those members serving terms from 2016-2019.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Fremont. Said emergency being the need to have a designee in place for training which will be held on April 8th, 2016.

This resolution, provided it receives a two-thirds yea or nay vote of all the members elected to the Fremont City Council, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the City of Fremont, approval by the Mayor, and publication and posting as required by law.




